Mineral reduction, iodine, sea breeze and citrus nuances. Supple and quite forward medium-bodied flavors possess more obvious power on the dry, focused and lingering citrus-tinged finish that tightens up as it sits on the palate.

An expressive nose of pear, Apple, Kiwi and white flowers. Accompanied by a light stony finish with touches of wood and warmth emerging.

Complex dominant of fruity scents, apple, honey and lovage. The on set in the mouth is moderately ample, round and heady. The wine evolves on a medium of marked liveliness, with a slight sparkling note.

'Jean-Pierre Moueix', a range of wines from Bordeaux, Saint-Émilion, and Pomerol, is crafted with care to express the nuances of fruit and terroir from these storied appellations.

Burgundy
Exceptionally aromatic wine that offers a true reflection of its Mercurey terroirs. The palate reveals a smooth, fruity attack and evolves towards notes of ripe red berries and a touch of vanilla. Well-integrated wood that brings a pleasant complexity.

Opens with gregarious scents of black cherries, warm plums and freshly crushed blackcurrants with touches of camphor, pencil lead and cloves plus a waft of lavender, medium to full-bodied.

There's a slightly herbal overtone to the citrusy aromas. Generous peach and melon notes on the medium to full-bodied palate, with an anise note on the finish.

Rhone
Baking spices, cola and raspberry notes all appear on the nose. It's full-bodied and velvety, folding in hints of french roast and dark chocolate on the lingering finish.
- FR23 2012 Reserve de la Comtesse** **\$168**
Bordeaux
It shows a lot of vibrant red berries, blackberries and darker plum fruits. The palate is impressive for the vibrant and lively acidity cast amid sturdy but supple tannins.
- FR24 2018 Faiveley NSG 1er Cru Porets St Georges** **\$188**
Burgundy
The nose discloses black fruits, toasty notes and a hint of oak. The smooth, round attack gives way to a powerful and structured mid-palate.

Made in a more floral, supple, Margaux-like style, the deep ruby/purple-hued and exhibits sweet, broad flavors, and plenty of tannin lurking beneath the surface.

Soft tannins and a pinch of fresh acidity that breaks apart the wine's rich fruit flavors. The hot vintage has taken well to the Barbera grape, accentuating its volume, richness and generosity. The bouquet offers black fruit, dried plum, spice, truffle-infused earth and toasted hazelnut.

Piedmont
Deep, dark fruit with a mingling of spice, tar and smoke.
- IT05 2015 Pio Cesare Barolo Mosconi** **\$238**
Piedmont
Incredibly perfumed with unique aromas of white truffles, peaches, dark berries and dried flowers. Fresh and bright. Full body, very silky tannins and a long and gorgeous finish. So progressive and seamless. Magnificent. First vintage of this single vineyard wine. Only 5,000. Starting drinking in 2023.

Tuscany
Deep, sultry and velvety. This Chianti is rich and supple on the palate with integrated tannins that are still tight.
- IT09 2019 Nittardi Belcanto Chianti** **\$88**
Tuscany
Aromas of blackberries, black cherries and some dried flowers. A full-bodied red with plenty of fruit and chewy tannins. From organically grown grapes. It's a structured young wine that needs time to soften.

Hawke's Bay
There are dark roses, raspberries, and notes of sandal wood and liquorice. Soft red and black summer fruits are balanced here by a thirst-quenching freshness.
- NZ03 2018 Te Mata Estate Coleraine** **\$178**
Hawke's Bay
Outlining notes of tobacco, earth and cassis with cedar and baking spices. Of course, the fruit is more intense than in most Bordeaux wines, showing ample freshness to while the medium to full-bodied palate is silky, framed by fine-grained tannins that give shape and length to the finish.
